Current certificate of insurance for your vehicle Only adult and examiner allowed in car during test, no one else is permitted. If an interpreter is needed, this must be provided by the customer.

Applicant must wear closed-toe shoes during test.

The cost for a road skills test by Courtesy Driving School is \$60 payable with credit/debit card at the time of scheduling. There are no refunds due to failure of the road skills test. In the event of failure, you may retake the road skills test after 24 hours for a retest fee of \$40.

Cancellation or change of a road skills test must be made at least 72 hours prior to the test, in order to avoid a \$25 fee. Failure to arrive on time to your test will result in a \$25 fee and no test.

Failure of the document or vehicle inspections will result in a \$30 fee and no test.

**<u>Vehicle Inspection</u>**: The following equipment cannot be damaged, inoperative, or missing in order to take a road skills test: brakes, exhaust system (muffler), horn, ALL LIGHTS MUST WORK (head lights, tail lights, brake lights, center-mounted rear brake light, turn signals), lug nuts, mirrors (rearview, outside left & right), safety belts and seats for all occupants, speedometer, springs, tires, wipers/washer fluid, windshield cannot be cracked or damaged, all driver and passenger doors must open from inside and outside. If applicant is a MINOR, vehicle must have back seat.
